

Rules and regulations

Jean Bilard Research Award

§1- The award rewards a thesis or a scientific publication in French or English, that allowed a significant progress of knowledge in the field of doping in sport, and having practical uses or repercussions in the prevention or fight against doping.

§2- This work should take place in at least one of the following research fields:

- Social and human sciences
- Sports and physical activities sciences
- Education sciences
- Health sciences (including medicine and pharmacology)
- Law
- Economics and management

§3- The candidate, aged under 35 at date, must personally present his application in the determined timeframe and send to the Foundation: 2 copies of his thesis or publication, 2 copies of his Phd defense report, if relevant, and 2 copies of his application letter. These documents will not be sent back to the candidate.
