Jean Bilard Research award

§1- Choice of the Prize winner :

The committee is composed of 6 Scholars, one of which being a member of the Foundations' Board. Its composition is determined yearly by its President Professor Gregory Ninot (University of Montpellier) in regard to the candidates and the disciplines of the submitted works. Committee members are selected primarily from the community of active scholars of the COMUE "Languedoc Roussillon Universités".

Each candidate will have his application reviewed by 2 committee members who will provide a written report on the submitted work.

The reunion of the committee will be held in Montpellier after being called by its President.

In the case of a justified absence of one of the committee members, said member will send his written reports to the President who will then submit them to the Committee.

The Committee can only deliberate in the presence of its President, with a minimum attendance of 4 members.

If said numbers are not reached, the president will call another meeting in the next 10 days.

The award winner is designated in the majority of expressed votes using a secret ballot. In the case of a tie between two candidates, the Voice of the President is decisive. Minutes of the meeting are proposed by the President and are signed by all attending committee members.

The name of the selected candidate is then communicated to the President of the Foundation and the commissars representing the association who will, in turn, inform said candidate.

§2- Challenging

The committee's decision or procedures can be challenged by any candidate within the 15 days following the vote. A conciliation procedure must be planned between the plaintiff, the Foundation, the Association and the President of the Committee. Without an agreement between parties, the courts of Law of Montpellier can be seized.

§3- Award ceremony

The Foundation of the University of Montpellier organizes a public award ceremony at the end of the Month of November, in the presence of the President of the University (or his representative), the President of the Foundation (or his representative), of the Professor Jean Bilard, the committee members, the commissars of the association, and any other invited person.

The award winner will receive 3000 euros and an official certification document
